# Amendments to MARPOL Annex I - Single Hull Tankers

In accordance with Resolution MEPC.111(50) Annex I and Annex II, we would like to inform IMO that the policies adopted by Hong Kong, China in allowing, suspending, withdrawing or declining the application of relevant requirements under MARPOL Annex I Regulation 13G and 13H when the amendments come into force on 5 April 2005.

The enclosed table detailed the policies of Hong Kong, China in the application of Regulation 13G and 13H to allow continued operation of single hull tankers and in permitting or denying entry of single hull oil tankers into the Hong Kong waters. In general, we follow the Annex I amendments in phasing out single hull tankers except relaxation would be granted to tankers less than 20 years old from their delivery date to operate beyond 2010.
